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## Lunchtime Supervisor

### Information:

Redmaids' High Junior School is a selective girls' school with a long tradition of high academic standards within a friendly and supportive community. We are a bustling and vibrant school with approximately 140 pupils. In September we will have 2 parallel classes of year groups 3, 4 and 5, and 3 classes in Year 6.

The school is situated in a pleasant residential area of Westbury-on-Trym, backing on to the Senior School site. We have a wonderful fully equipped play area with additional grass and astro areas.

We are seeking to appoint a person to jointly supervise the girls, aged 7-11, during their lunchtime break.

Hours: 12.30 to 1.40 pm

Rate: £10.80 per session

### The key responsibilities are:

- Collect girls from the Senior School dining hall at 12.30pm and lead them out to the sunken garden to play or directly back to the Junior School.
- The Lunchtime Supervisor must encourage the girls to play co-operatively and give special attention to girls who are on their own.
- The Lunchtime Supervisor should always bear in mind that the school's pastoral policy is to encourage girls to mix across the year groups as much as possible and that the playground is an ideal place for this to happen.
- Girls are allowed to play sensibly with the equipment provided.
- If a child is injured and needs medical attention, the Lunchtime Supervisor is to send for a first-aider.
- The Lunchtime Supervisor must safeguard and promote the welfare of all pupils in and visiting the school.
- Carry out any other reasonable duties associated with the role, as requested by the Headteacher.
