Sixth Form Dress code

- Redmaids' High sport clothing when you are taking part in activities afternoon on a Tuesday

You may also choose to wear:

- Professional tailored 'city' shorts (just above the knee)
- Plain smart black trainers (no other colour should be visible)

- Coming into school feeling smart, comfortable and ready to learn
- How you want others to see you
